BART PLAZA South Berkeley Dispossessed Developers will present this concept of a potential development for the air rights above the Ashby BART station during the Tuesday morning City Council session. This \$17.4 million project would be a community-owned and community-developed "Plaza of Progress," according to Ray Dobard, president of the dispossessed developers. It would contain a low and a moderate rent housing structure, commercial enterprises, a cultural center, a bandstand, a child care center, a medical center, and a vocational training facility, Dobard said. About 200 persons would be employed after the de-Vetopment was in operation, and it would generate roughly \$600,000 in real property taxes.
